DEMOLITION HAS BEGUN!

Our contractor has begun work on the outside of our facilities. As a result, we will no longer be able to enter from the Preschool entrance or from the Office area entrance on the White Avenue side.

Parking Details for March 25 and for the duration of the project:

- We will need to reserve our closest parking in the back parking lot for our Senior Adults, handicapped individuals, and for families with young children.
- If the adjacent lots are filled, then please park in the parking spaces around the old K-1 Center / Fairhoper's Park on Church Street and Summit Street.
- There will be two (2) Gulf Coast trolleys running a continuous loop to and from the K-1 Center / Fairhoper's Park from 7:45 AM - 12:30 PM.
- Feel free to drop off your family at either the White Avenue entrance or Nichols Avenue covered drive and then go park.

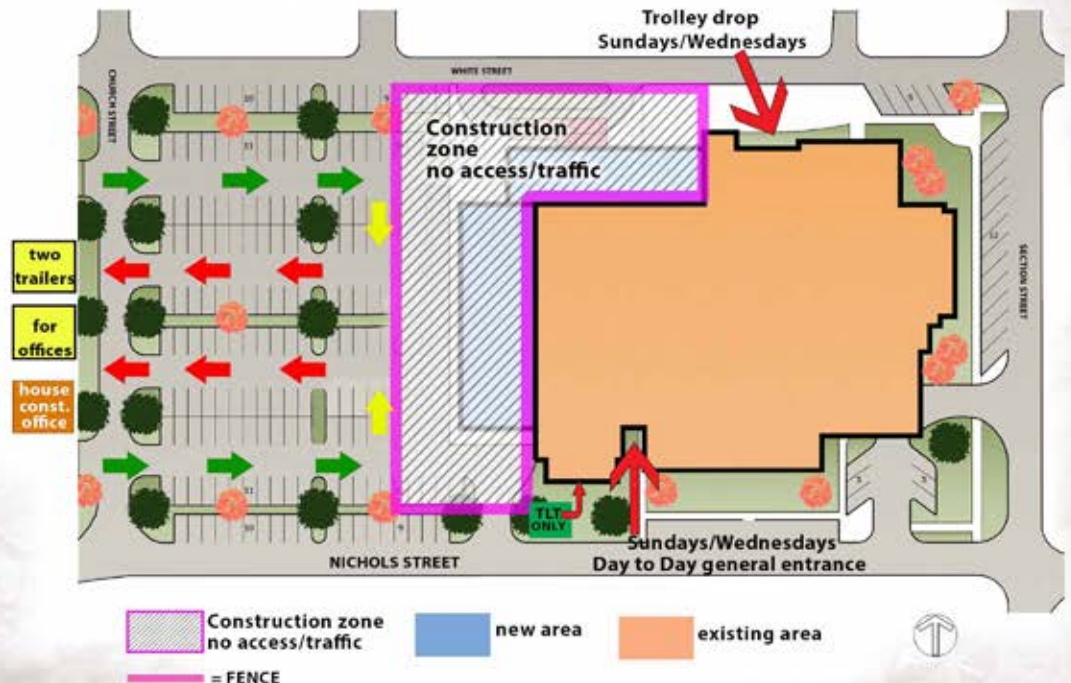

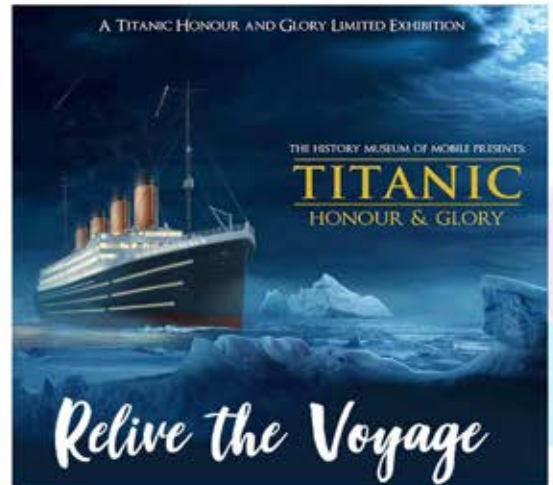
